Our Two's Class

We've learned about the miracles of Jesus. Jesus raised Lazarus and Jairus' daughter from the dead. We wrapped Lazarus like a mummy, then unwrapped him when Jesus told him to 'come out from the tomb'. In an experiment we put red paint in a cup, then poured in water and it turned red. Now, our water was just red water and paint, but we talked about how Jesus' miracle was real and He actually changed the water to wine. Then we learned about the miraculous catch of fish, gluing fish to boats and did some fishy color matching. We explored how white crayon markings will pop out of the white paper mysteriously if you paint over them with watercolors. Last we discovered that Jesus healed a blind man. We wore black out glasses to pretend we couldn't see and tried to guess the object with just smell, touch, and taste.

In April we will explore the Parables of Jesus, Palm Sunday, and the Easter story. We will make Easter crafts like the Cross; & a carrot / bunny made by painting our feet.

March came in like a lamb and as we feel the cooler weather again it is leaving like a lion. We did have some beautiful days on the playground. Some of us even got red from the sun. 



