Your monthly billing sheet shows the amount you paid (Fall 2022); but for those who were enrolled with us last year don't forget about payments in the Spring/Summer (Jan - July 2022) payments; let Mr Heidle know if you need those figures or a print out.



Emergency Closings!

Since we do not rely on busing, we do <u>not</u> follow the closings of public schools. IF we close for weather (or any other purpose) you will receive an email from ILS or a group text from your child's teacher. Or listen for "Immanuel Lutheran School, <u>Danville</u>" (not Immanuel Lutheran Preschool – there is another in our region) on WCIA, D102, KRock, WDAN, WITY, KISS, KOOL for closing information.

Tuition / Fees

ILS now has 77 students! Thank you to EVERYONE staying current on tuition, lunch, BeforeCare, and other payments! Your prompt payments are greatly appreciated! All tuition and other fees are due on the 10th and late after the 15th! If you are struggling to keep up, please speak with Mr. Heidle to set up a payment plan that will work or see about financial aid. Lunch and other fees can be paid by cash, check, or EFT – if you want to use EFT simply write "EFT" by the balance due with your signature or initials and return it to the school office and we'll set it up! IF you need to change the date/details of a scheduled EFT, be sure to call/text Mr Heidle several days in advance! *We're here to help!!*
