

FAITHFUL GATHERING IN EVERY SEASON:

The Board recently discussed how worship services are handled during inclement weather and would like to share this guidance. Historically, the cancellation of worship services at Immanuel has been, and will continue to be, a very rare occurrence. If severe weather is forecast and a cancellation must be considered, a decision will be made by 6 am on Sundays and by 3 pm on Wednesdays. Pastor Yonkers will record a message on the church's outgoing voicemail with the final decision to either cancel services or proceed as scheduled. Members and guests may call the church office at 442-5675 after 6:30 am on Sunday morning to hear the most up-to-date information. When weather conditions are poor, but services are not cancelled, we encourage everyone to prioritize safety and use their own judgment when deciding whether to attend. We value gathering together for worship while also caring for one another's well-being.
